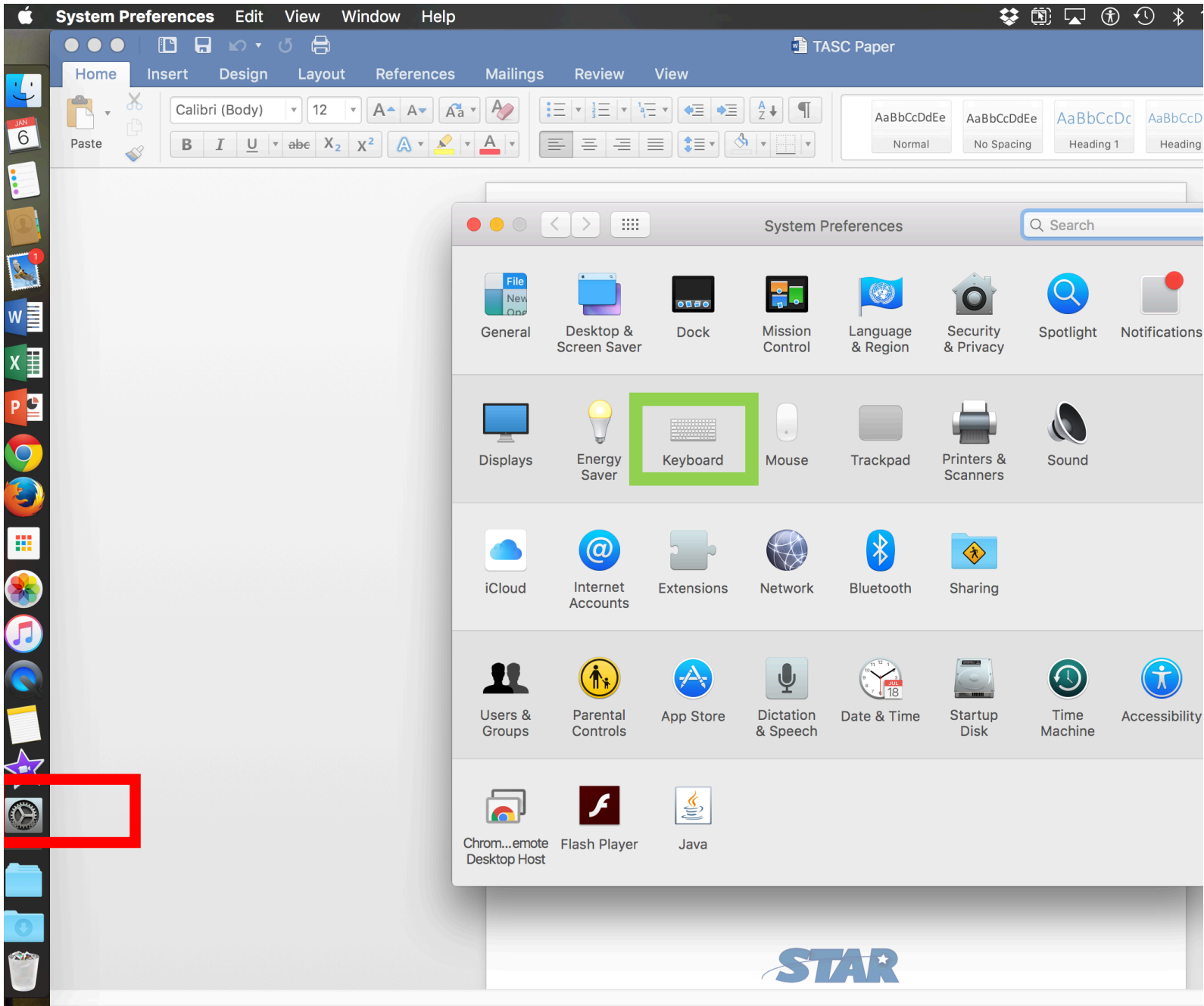


## How to Access the On-Screen Keyboard in OS X El Capitan for Macs

2. Click on “keyboard”



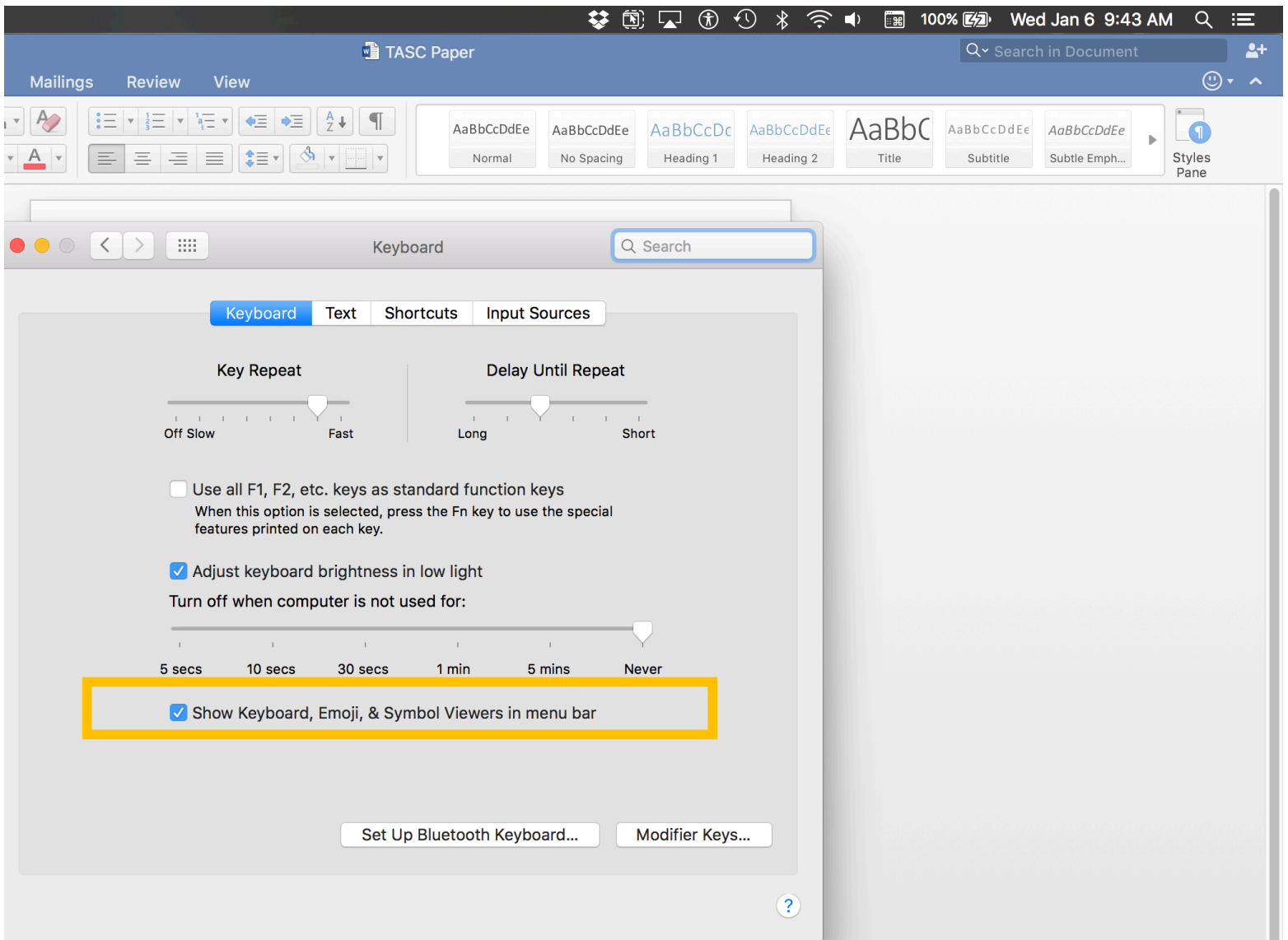

3. Once in the Keyboard option make sure the “ Show Keyboard, Emoji, & Symbol viewers in menu bar” has a blue check next to it

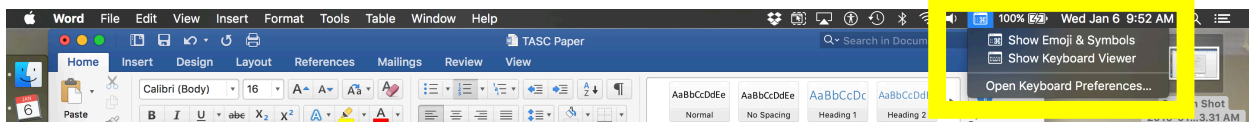
