Social Emotional	<ul> <li>Identifying boy or girl</li> <li>Identifying who to ask for help</li> <li>Turn taking</li> </ul> Is not observant, does not share	<ul> <li>One Potato Head, divide parts</li> <li>Make girl and boy Potato Heads</li> <li>Community helper</li> </ul>
